1	Internship Program	Our SEU offers internships to area college students for required credits in communications/broadcasting, marketing, and journalism curriculums. These students obtain hands-on instruction which is considered toward completion of their majors.
		During this reporting period, our SEU hosted three (3) student interns from the University of Tennessee's Media/Broadcasting department(s), who were supervised by our Market Manager, Promotions Directors, Program Directors, and Sales Managers and received training in many facets of radio broadcasting by working closely with personnel in each department. The students were also able to seek career advice from SEU staff.
2	Scholarship Program	The Citadel Broadcasting of Knoxville Journalism Scholarship was created by our SEU years ago to aid students pursuing an education in Journalism, Mass Media, or Media Technologies from Pellissippi State Technical Community College, located in Knoxville, Tennessee. A scholarship in the minimum amount of \$350 is awarded to one student annually who meets the eligibility requirements established for the Program.
3	Host event/program sponsored by a community organization relating to careers in broadcasting	On August 15, 2019, our SEU hosted a breakfast tour of our facilities for members of the Farragut Chamber of Commerce, during which our market manager and members of the sales and programming departments shared what it takes to operate a cluster of radio stations as well as the variety of careers opportunities available in broadcasting.
4	Participate in Job Fair	On October 9, 2019, our Promotions Director attended the University of Tennessee Job and Internship Fair, held on its campus, during which job and internship opportunities at our stations were discussed with students interested in pursuing careers in radio broadcasting.

The Radio Talent Institute provides the campus-to-career connection that students seek to begin their career in broadcasting while enabling broadcasters to discover and hire entry-level talent.
8	Participate in event/program sponsored by an educational institution and community organization relating to careers in broadcasting (8)	Each month beginning September, 2019 – March, 2020, our SEU in collaboration with Shoney's Restaurants and Knox County Schools participate in "Shoney's Super Kid" program. Knoxville area Shoney's and Knox County Schools select a child to spotlight and present with an award! Each child that wins is welcomed by our SEU for an on-air interview on WOKI-FM, and receives a station tour along with a few friends that includes a question-and-answer session about opportunities in radio.
9	Management-level training regarding methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and prevention of discrimination and harassment	During the month of April 2019, this SEU participated in harassment prevention training. All SEU employees were required to complete a course prepared by ThinkHR entitled, "Workplace Harassment Prevention," designed to address sexual harassment with a focus on the forms of harassment prohibited by federal law. The course presented best practices for updating policies and procedures, reporting incidents, and following up on complaints. The course for managers was more extensive than the course for staff members. In order to obtain a certificate of participation, employees were required to take a quiz following their completion of the tutorial.
